Selected papers from MAMERN09 will be published as a Special Issue of the Journal **MATHEMATICS AND COMPUTERS IN SIMULATION** (<http://www.elsevier.com/locate/matcom/>).

Submission of an article implies that the **work described has not been published previously, that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere**, that its publication is approved by all Authors. All submitted papers will be evaluated according to the standard journal refereeing procedure.

Please keep the following information in mind when preparing your paper for submission:

- The manuscripts should be submitted as soon as possible and definitely no later than **November 15<sup>th</sup> 2009**.
- Papers in **English** for the **Special Issue MAMERN 2009** should not exceed **15 pages**.
